## Where do I go?

### Preparing for leaving the building

I have considered	✓
Whether the immediate area outside the building is safe and what hazards I may encounter on the way.	
Possible event development (eg, fire, following an earthquake, floodwaters rising).	
How I will get home, based on the circumstances of the event.	
What the current conditions are, for example: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• weather</li> <li>• time of day</li> <li>• volume of people using the same route – is it better to wait?</li> </ul>	
What advice Civil Defence is giving (on the radio, Facebook, Twitter)	

## What do I do?

1. Take a deep breath.
2. Count to 10. Tell yourself you can handle the situation.
3. Check for danger. Protect yourself and the injured person from fire, explosions, or other hazards.
4. Try to look at the situation as a whole.
